Terms of Reference

Furnishing of a Moot Court at the Ethiopian Federal Legal and Justice Research and Training Institute

Background

The objective of the Better Migration Management (BMM) II program is to improve migration management in the Eastern African region in response to the needs identified by the African countries of the Khartoum Process, and, in particular, to address the trafficking of human beings and the smuggling of migrants within and from the Horn of Africa in a rights-based and migrant-centered way.

The BMM program has three components:

- Migration governance (C1);
- Effective institutions in migration management (C2); and
- Protection of vulnerable migrants (C3).

The Ethiopian Federal Justice and Legal Research and Training Institute, here after referred to as the Institute or EFJLRTI, is one of the central partners of the BMM II programme with regards to implementation foreseen under component two. The Institute provides pre- and in-service training as well as short-term courses for judges, prosecutors and other Ethiopian law enforcement entities. Through funding from the European Union, a new training site has been built and inaugurated in May 2019. As part of Component 2 and the programme's Annual Work Plan Activity 2.2.1.7, the BMM II programme intends to provide furniture so that the Institute can fully commence its training and learning activities. A central part is the provision of a moot court where judges, prosecutors, and lawyers in-training can practice court proceedings and practically implement the trained-upon topics.

As set forth above, GIZ as part of the BMM II programme would like to support the Institute by providing a fully-equipped moot court. To this end, GIZ/BMM II would like to procure wood furniture to furnish the moot court room. The technical and design specifications as well as dimensions and sample pictures can be found in the annex. In addition to providing the wood items, the selected carpenter is also expected to:

- Take measurements of the room at the training center in which the items are to be installed;
- Provide a design proposal in line with the dimensions, design suggestions and technical specifications provided by GIZ in the annex;

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- Build the furniture of the moot court according to the required items listed in the annex and below:
 - o 1 x judge's bench
 - o 1 x defendant's stand
 - o 1 x witness stand
 - o 2 x seating benches
 - o 2 x tables
 - o 3 x vintage judge's chair
 - o 1 x court gravel
- Transport all materials and required tools for installation to the Institute, located around Ayat; and
- Install all items at the Institute around Ayat.

NB: All measurements in the annex are provided in **cm** and the wood material should be **wanza** and have a coherent appearance in terms of looks and wood/wood paint used.

Bidding Procedure

Interested companies should submit both, a technical specification, financial offer and warranty period. The technical offer should correspond to the technical specifications and measurements provided in the annex and the financial offer should include prices for items to be provided as well as costs for transportation, taking measurements, etc.

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
